- (I) *On Saturdays & Sundays only at 1:00 pm
- (II) **On Saturdays & Sundays only at 4:00 pm
- (III)¶Priests will perform this auspicious religious service at the homes of devotees bringing with them pancha loha vigrahas. Service must be booked <u>one week in advance</u>.
- (IV) **All services** (except Archana) must be scheduled at least **one week in advance.**
- (V) Services on scheduled days should also be booked at least ½ hour prior to commencement of service.
- (VI) An additional charge of \$51 will be levied for:
 - a) ***Outside (above 25 miles)
 - b) Overnight Stay of priests(s)
 - c) Each additional service(s)

DAKSHINA & GRATUITY POLICY

One of the primary goals of our Temple has been and continues to be, to provide the highest levels of religious and other ancillary services to the devotees either at the Temple or at their homes. We are immensely pleased to acknowledge that, thanks to the relentless efforts of our dedicated priests and the ancillary kitchen staff, we have come a long way in this respect. In order to improve our services further, we are now informing the devotees requesting our priests' services outside and inside the Temple confirming the event indicating the name of the priest assigned for the service well in advance. We constantly evaluate feedback from the devotees with the objective wherever possible of improving the quality of our services and implement their suggestions. It is only natural that the satisfied devotees wish to express their sincere appreciation by generously giving dakshina to the priests and gratuity to the kitchen/community center staff.

However, due to the exigencies dictated by the needs of the Temple, it is not always possible to assign all the priests to provide outside services at all times, without impacting the quality of service provided in the Temple. Nonetheless, the *Devasthānam* strongly believes that the priests assigned to perform services in the Temple should not be deprived of the opportunity to earn dakshina by performing services outside.

In order to be fair to all the priests, the *Devasthānam* has established an equitable system by which the *dakshina* earned by all the priests for services rendered both inside and outside the Temple will be pooled and distributed equally among ALL THE PRIESTS so that "no priest is left behind". Likewise, a separate pool has been established for the gratuity earned by the kitchen staff and the Community Center staff and funds in these pools will be equally distributed among ALL THE KITCHEN STAFF & ALL THE COMMUNITY CENTER STAFF respectively.

This pooling system and the equitable distribution of *dakshina*/gratuity among the staff, however, will be effective only if the devotees fully understand the rationale behind it and observe the following suggestions:

- As far as possible, please DO NOT make cash payments.
- Please make your payment BY ONE CHECK payable to The Hindu Temple Society of North America or by CREDIT or DEBIT CARD.
- Please ENCLOSE the check in the envelope provided and give it to the priest.
- Please COMPLETE the form printed on the envelope or the card for the Kitchen/Community Center staff showing the allocation of your payment between services, pooja samagri,dakshina/gratuity etc.

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS TO THE TEMPLE

By Automobile: (A) If you are driving from Manhattan or points West, take I-495 East (Long Island Expressway) to Exit 24 (Kissena Blvd) and turn LEFT at Kissena Blvd.

(B) If you are driving from Long Island or points East, take I-495 West (Long Island Expressway) to Exit 24 (Kissena Blvd) and turn RIGHT at Kissena Blvd.

Drive about a mile on Kissena Blvd and turn RIGHT into Holly Avenue. Drive 3 blocks on Holly Avenue to Bowne Street. The Temple is on the LEFT side.

- (C) If you are driving from Connecticut or points North, take I-95 South to I-678 South (Van Wyck Expressway). After crossing Whitestone Bridge, stay on I-678 South (RIGHT lane) and take Exit 15 to 20th Ave. At the traffic light, turn LEFT into Parsons Blvd and drive about 2.5 miles. At Flushing Hospital Medical Center (on RIGHT), turn RIGHT into 45th Ave and drive to next block. At Smart Street, turn LEFT and drive to the end of the street to Temple Parking Lot behind the temple.
- (D) If you are driving from Princeton, Philadelphia or points South, take I-278 via Staten Island and take Exit 35 to I-495 East (Long Island Expressway) and follow directions as above (A).

By Public Transportation: Take Subway Train No. 7 from Times Square to Flushing Main Street (the last stop on 7 train). Then take MTA Bus Q27 from Main Street to Bowne Street on Holly Avenue. The bus runs on Kissena Blvd and turns left into Holly Ave Bus Stop. The next stop is Bowne Street near the temple. The bus ride is about 5 to 10 minutes. You may also take MTA Buses Q17, Q25 and Q34 to Kissena Blvd and Holly Avenue and walk two short blocks to the temple.

Long Island Rail Road (LIRR) Trains from Penn Station / Woodside to Port Washington also stop in Flushing Main Street, adjacent to 7 train.
