# A Letter From the President

Dear Fellow Devotees,

Namaste. We hope, having been almost released from the grip of the pandemic, you had enjoyable *Šri Ganeša Chaturthi*, *Deepāvali* and *Šri Devi Navarātri* festivals. All major festivals including the 45<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Temple, *Šri Sudaršana Mahā Yajnam*, *Šri Rāghavendra Swāmy Ārādhana*, *Deepāvali* and *Šri Devi Navarātri* festivals were celebrated as usual with more number of devotees participating after relaxation of two year long pandemic-related restrictions (except masking). The most important festival celebrated was *Mahā Kumbhābhishekam*, 5<sup>th</sup> consecration of the *Devasthānam* performed from August 31<sup>st</sup> thru September 7<sup>th</sup> (previously postponed in 2020 due to the unfortunate pandemic) and the annual *Šri Ganeša Chaturthi* celebrations August 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> and continued September 8<sup>th</sup> thru September 11<sup>th</sup>.

In order to celebrate the once-in-12-year religious event, consecration of the Devasthanam was performed strictly according to Agama šastra with the addition of 33 priests, from other Temples within the US and from India. In addition to the main homa kunda dedicated to Šri Mahã Vallabha Ganapati, homa kundas were erected where elaborate services followed by simultaneous Poornahuti were performed daily to the delight of the devotees present. The 108 Kanya and 108 Sumangali poojas, the procession of all the priests in their colorful silk dress chanting veda mantras both in mornings and evenings on two days, the procession of beautifully decorated panchamoorthy vigrahas (Šri Mahã Vallabha Ganapati Šri Siva, Šri Shanmukha, Šri Venkatešwara and Šri Hanuman) devotedly carried by our Temple's dedicated volunteer force to the accompaniment of mellifluous nagaswara music were some of the highlights of the event. The simultaneous mangala hãrati on the last day at all the homa kundas was a soulful sight. The Kumbhãbhishekam of all the vimanas including that of Lord Ganeša performed by all the priests simultaneously on the last day (September 7<sup>th</sup>) was very pleasing both to the eyes and heart of all. Thousands of devotees witnessed this grand sight thronging in front of the Temple. Šri Ganeša Chaturthi festival was also celebrated with usual grandeur on August 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> and continued September 8<sup>th</sup> thru September 11<sup>th</sup>. This concluded with grand Ratha Yātra in which Šri Mahā Ganapati was taken in the beautiful silver Ratha (chariot) around the streets of Flushing. In addition to many dignitaries and elected officials, NYC Mayor, Mr. Eric Adams also participated in this event. All the events were live-streamed for the benefit of absentee-devotees.

The dedicated service of the *Devasthanam* staff, the sincere volunteers, security staff and last but not the least the cooperation of devotees need special mention. Excellent arrangements for the continuous distribution of food *prasadam* to devotees were made to the satisfaction of the devotees.

I thank you for your support through your valuable and generous contributions in the past and I appeal to you for your continued patronage and we will do our best to serve you and the Temple.

May the blessings of Šri Mahã Vallabha Ganapati be always with you and your families.

### KUMBHÃBHISHEKAM 2022

(Highlights of some of the Preliminary Preparations)

The much awaited 5<sup>th</sup> consecration of the Temple was successfully performed on September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Even though the ceremonial rituals took place from August 31<sup>st</sup> through September 7<sup>th</sup>, the preliminary and preparatory work commenced 2 years ahead and with the combined team effort all the planned activities were executed meticulously.

Several renovations were performed before the 5<sup>th</sup> consecration such as beautification and enrichment of all the *vimãnams* of the *Parivãra Devata Sannidhis*, *Šri Pãrvati*, *Šri Kãmãkshi*, *Šri Hanumãn* and *Dwajasthambam*. All the *gopurams* were renovated, painted and covered with nets to prevent damage from the birds. New *kalašams* were installed on all the *gopurams* and *vimãnams*. The 32 shrines of *Ganeša* around the outer circle of the Temple were beautified by fixing an artistic altar on each made of reinforced fiberglass material. *Rajata* (silver) and *Swarna* (gold) *bandhanam*, a metallic binding installed tightly over the *ashtabandhana* as the topmost layer for *Šri Šiva*, *Šri Pãrvati*, *Šri Kãmãkshi*, *Šri Shanmukha Valli Devasena*, *Šri Venkatešwara*, *Šri Mahã Lakshmi* and *Šri Hanumãn*. Similarly, *Rajata* (silver) *bandhanam* were installed for *Šri Mooshika-Balipeetam*, *Šri Nandi-Balipeetam* and *Šri Mayura-Balipeetam*.

New granite stone-carved *Kumbha Chandikešwara* and *Dwani Chandikešwara* were installed and consecrated in the *koshtam* of *Šri Ganeša* and *Šri Šiva Sannidhis*. New *panchaloha* (alloy of five metals) *moorthies* were also installed and consecrated for *Chandikešwara*, *Trišula Devar* and *Sudarsana Chakra*. A new copper with gold electroplating sheet engraved with the *pranava mantra OM* was installed inside top ceiling of the *Šri Ganeša Sannidhi* replacing the old one.

As part of the ceremonial rituals, Temple had arranged 108 *Sumangali Pooja* and *Bãla Pooja*. There was an overwhelming response and the whole *yãgašãla* was filled with *sumangalis* and children. Several devotees appreciated it and suggested that the Temple should arrange these kinds of *poojas* on an annual basis. Installation of a big LED TV in the food section to view all the ceremonies live was a big attraction and much appreciated by the devotees.
