Meaning

I bow to the ferocious, chivalrous, (an avatar of) *Mahā Vishnu*, radiant faced, omnipresent, Lord *Narasimha*, the frightful, bestower of auspiciousness and killer of the fear of death or the cycle of birth and death.

(This popular *śloka* glorifies the *Nava Narasimha* – the nine forms of *Narasimha*)
