Navagraha Stotram in English

1. **Japā Kusuma Sankāśam Kāśyapeyam Mahādyutim I**
Tamorim Sarva Pāpaghnam Prañatosmi Divākaram II
I prostrate before the Sun god, who has infinite effulgence, who has the complexion of Japā Kusuma (red hibiscus flower), who is the son of sage Kāśyapa, who removes darkness, who destroys all sins of his devotees and who reigns the day.
2. **Dadhi Śankha Tushārābham Kshîrodārñava Sambhavam I**
Namāmi Śašinam Somam Śambhor Mukuta Bhooshañam II
I offer my obeisance to the Moon god, who has the complexion of curd or conch or mist, who originates from the Milky Ocean and who decorates Lord Śiva's crown.
3. **Dharañi Garbha Sambhootam Vidyut Kānti Sama Prabham I**
Kumāram Śakti Hastam Tam Mangalam Prañamāmyaham II
I prostrate before Angāraka, the son of Mother Earth, who has a luster comparable to lightning, who is youthful and holds śakti in his hands and who bestows auspiciousness on his devotees.
4. **Priyangukalikāśyāmam Roopeñāpratimam Budham I**
Soumyam Soumyaguñopetam Tam Budham Prañamāmyaham II
I bow down to Budha, who is as dark as a saffron bud and has an incomparable form, who is the son of Soma (the Moon), who is wise and possesses a peaceful demeanor.
5. **Devānām Cha Řisheeñām Cha Gurum Kānchana Sannibham I**
Buddhibhootam Trilokeśam Tam Namāmi Bŗhaspatim II
I offer my obeisance to Bŗhaspati, who is the preceptor of gods as well as great sages, who has the complexion of gold, who is endowed with a sharp intellect and who is the master of the three worlds.
6. **Hima Kunda Mŗñālābham Daityānām Paramam Gurum I**
Sarva Śāstra Pravaktāram Bhārgavam Prañamāmyaham II
I prostrate before Śukra, the son of sage Bhŗgu, who has the complexion of snow or jasmine flower or the inner lotus stem, who is the preceptor of demons and who imparts all the scriptures to his disciples.
7. **Neelānjana Samābhāsam Raviputram Yamāgrajam I**
Chhāyā Mārtānda Sambhootam Tam Namāmi Śanaischaram II
I offer my obeisance to Śanaischara, who has a blue complexion and is a son of the Sun god born through Chhāyā Devi and who is the elder brother of Yama, the God of Death.
8. **Ardhakāyam Mahāveeryam Chandrāditya Vimardanam I**
Simhikā Garbha Sambhootam Tam Rāhum Prañamāmyaham II
I bow down to Rāhu, who is endowed with only half body but with immense valor, who devours the Sun and the Moon and who is born out of the womb of Simhikā.
9. **Palāśa Pushpa Sankāśam Tārakāgraha Mastakam I**
Roudram Roudrātmakam Ghoram Tam Ketum Prañamāmyaham II
I offer my obeisance to Ketu, who has the complexion of a palāśa flower, who is the leader of stars and planets, who is ghastly in nature and has a ghastly appearance.
