Mahã Kumbhãbhishekam 2022

A Temple acquires significance, among other things, by the deities enshrined in it. The temple, as a structure is an abode for the deities, and as an institution provides a place for the devotees to worship the deities. The Agama scriptures deal with both dimensions of the temple which is built by collective effort its sustenance by collective interest. The temple is not just a building but is an image, a conception of divinity.

As per Ãgama scriptures, a Hindu temple culture includes general framework of religious and philosophical aspects of temple structure, installation of icon/deity, worship, ceremonies, rituals, assembly of devotees and festivals. It also includes other aspects such as aesthetics, art, culture, society, community, economy, education, recreation and so on. These are formalized consciously and deliberately. One must have an intuitive awareness of the presence of divinity, energy and vibration which makes the temple a sacred enclosure, and must be eager to partake of that spiritual presence. Temple creates an atmosphere or appropriate mood of holiness and sanctity that enables a devotee to be more receptive to the spiritual presence.

Kumbhãbhishekam (consecration) of a temple is a collection of complex ceremonies which are essentially religious in significance. The rituals are meant to secure a divine presence in the deity installed at the sanctum sanctorum and to maintain the sanctity of the shrine. The ritual of consecration also infuses a new power, at once spiritual and occult, into the deity, so that when a devotee does worship, he or she partakes this power, according to his or her own predisposition, understanding, capacity and devotion.

At the appropriate auspicious moment (muhurta time), with the energizing spell of vedic recitations, chanting of divine names, playing of musical instruments, blowing of the conch, echoing ringing of the bell, the main ritual of sprinkling of the sacred water on Gopura-Vimãna (towers and domes) and showering of the deities and shrines in a ceremonial way with the sacred water in the pot, the consecration (Kumbhãbhishekam) ceremony is performed.

Priests then offer prayers to the deities seeking the cosmic energy to dwell

in the icon (vigraha) forever, for the sake of conferring blessings on all living beings. The deities and shrines thus get energized with renewed power. The sacred water is then sprinkled on all the devotees present. Worshiping the newly energized, fully manifested form of all-pervading supreme being (sakala murti)
